General Rules and Conditions governing the grant of scholarships

- No student shall be eligible to avail the benefit of more than one scholarship at the University, College, School, or Trust level.
- No scholarship of any kind shall be granted at the institutional level; however, if deemed necessary, the case may be referred to the Trust Office accompanied by a recommendation from the concerned institution's office bearers.
- A student shall be eligible to avail the benefit of a scholarship at the University only if they maintain an **attendance record of more than 75 percent**.
- To qualify for a scholarship at the University it is mandatory for the student to **deposit their fees by the stipulated deadline**. Late submission of fees shall render the student ineligible for any form of scholarship.
- The scholarship amount granted shall be **adjusted against the final installment of the tuition fees**, provided that all other installments of the tuition fees have been deposited on time.
- The scholarship calculation applies solely to the tuition fees; it does not include development fees, transportation fees, or any other miscellaneous charges.
- If a student incurs an ATKT (Allowed to Keep Terms) or a supplementary examination requirement in any semester or class during the entire duration of their course, they shall be rendered ineligible for the scholarship.
- Among siblings studying at University or College within the Shri Vaishnav Group—specifically those studying at the same University or College—the youngest sibling shall be granted educational assistance, provided that the tuition fees for both siblings have been deposited on time.
- In the case of a student studying at University, if their father (or the single guardian responsible for the student's care) passes away or suffers from an incurable illness, financial assistance shall be provided by the Trust.

Rules for Students Belonging to OBC, SC, and ST Categories

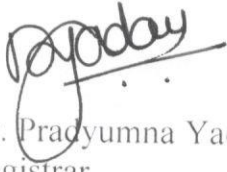
- A student eligible for a government scholarship shall be deemed eligible for a scholarship provided at the University/College/School level only after adjusting the amounts received from the government in the form of scholarships, financial aid, or other fee reimbursements.
- If the government scholarship amount is equal to or exceeds the scholarship amount provided at the University/College/School level, the student shall not be granted any benefit by the University/ College/ School.
- If the government scholarship amount is less than the scholarship provided at the University/ College/ School level, the University/ College/School shall provide the difference amount, up to the prescribed maximum limit of the University/College/School scholarship.

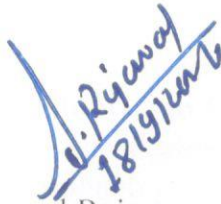

The implementation of the aforementioned scheme shall be carried out at the University/College/School level. To this end, after completing the necessary formalities on the prescribed application form (as previously stipulated) and obtaining the recommendations of the Head of the Institution and its office bearers, the application forms—accompanied by a list of applicants—shall be forwarded to the Trust Office for further necessary action, thereby enabling the Trust to disburse the scholarship funds to the respective institution.

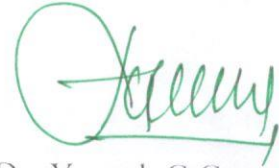
All the aforementioned scholarships shall come into effect from the upcoming academic session, 2026-27.
