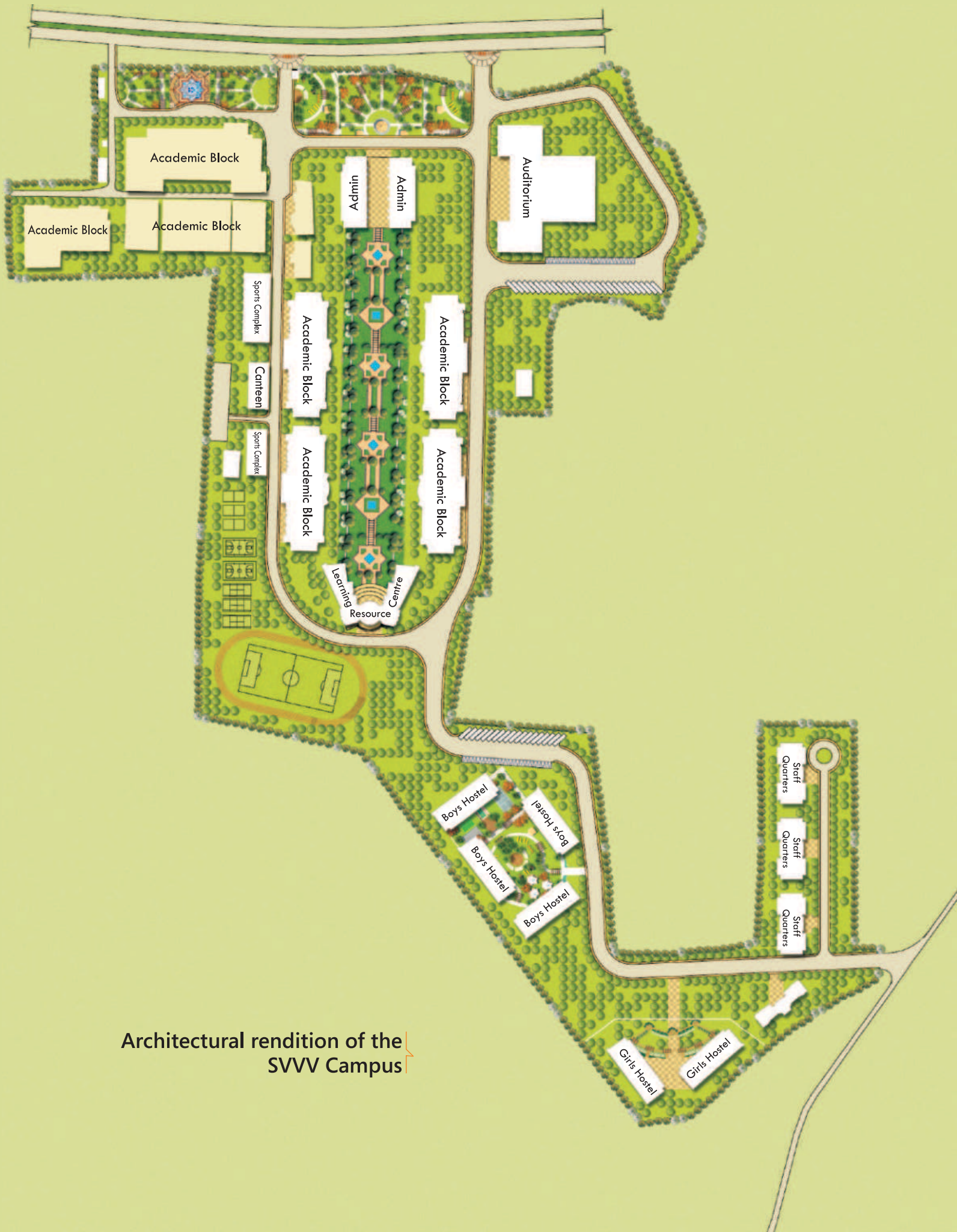

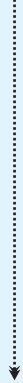

INDORE

(AN EMERGING EDUCATIONAL HUB OF CENTRAL INDIA)

The currently known Indore was established in 810 AD by the King Pal Rajvansh. He built the Indreshwar temple. The name of the city has origin in it. Indore was later known as Malwa. In the year 1766, Khanderao Holkar and his wife Devi Ahilyabai Holkar started ruling over the Malwa. At that time, Maheshwar was the capital and Indore was an army camp and a small village. To design the evolving capital city of Holkars in the early 20th century, Sir Patrick A Geddes (October 2, 1854-April 17, 1932), a globally acclaimed urban planner and educationist, planned the modern Indore.

Indore has earned a great reputation in the field of education not only in Central India but also in India and abroad. Indore has a large student population and is a big educational centre. Indore hosts both Indian Institute of Management (Established in 1996) and Indian Institute of Technology (Established in 2009). IIT Indore ranked 13 under engineering category and IIM Indore ranked 6 under management category in the National Institute Ranking Framework.

The Daly College, founded in 1870 by General Henry Daly, is one of the oldest co-educational boarding schools in the world. The Holkar Science College, officially known as Government Model Autonomous Holkar Science College was established in 1891. The Mahatma Gandhi Memorial Medical College, established in 1878 as the King Edward Medical School, is one of the oldest medical colleges in India, run by the government. It is attached to tertiary teaching hospitals named Maharaja Yeshwantrao group of Hospitals established in 1955.

To initiate and strengthen agricultural research and development in Malwa and Nimar regions, the Institute of Plant Industry came into existence in the year 1924. Later, in the year 1959, the Government College of Agriculture, Indore was established with the merger of the erstwhile Institute of Plant Industry. Shri Govindram Seksaria Institute of Technology and Science, established in 1952, got the status of an autonomous institution in 1989. In 2020, it became the first and only MP government-funded engineering college in the state to have made its place among the top 250 in the NIRF. The College of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry, MHOW, founded in 1955, is one of the oldest veterinary colleges in Madhya Pradesh.

Apart from these reputed institutions, Indore is also blessed that the age old social and charitable trusts are also contributing to the field of education. To name a few, Shri Vaishnav Group of Trusts, Shri Gujarati Samaj Trust, Loha Vyapari Parmarthik Trust and Shri Sathya Sai Trust are well known amongst others. Existence of 12 Universities, 59 Engineering Colleges, 3 Medical Colleges, 93 Management Colleges, 4 Dental Colleges, 2 Ayurvedic Colleges and 5 Homeopathic Colleges is the testimony of city's prominence in the field of education.

Carrying the legacy of Maa Ahilya Bai Holkar, many eminent personalities have been associated with Indore. To name a few, Maharaja Yashwant Rao Holkar (Nepolian of India), Bharat Ratna Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar, Padma Bhushan Smt. Sumitra Mahajan, Former MP and Speaker of Lok Sabha, Field Marshal Sam Bahadur Manekshaw (Former Commandant, Infantry School, MHOW), Field Marshal K M Kariyappa (an alumnus of Indore Daly College), General K Sundarji, Air Chief Marshal Shachindra Pal Tyagi, Late Shri Radha Kishan (Freedom Fighter and social activist), Late Prakash Chandra Sethi (Former CM of M.P. from Indore and Former Cabinet Minister of the Government of India).

Apart from being a historical city, Indore has a very rich cultural heritage too. Indore is privileged to be the Janma Bhoomi of Bharat Ratna Swar Samragyi Lata Mangeshkar, famous comedian Johny Walker and the Karma Bhoomi of Padma Bhushan Ustad Amir Khan, Padma Bhushan Gukulotsavji Maharaj, Padma Vibhushan M.F. Hussain, Padma Shri Bhalu Mondhe, Dr. Rahat Indori, Ustad Rais Khan (Sitarist), Dagar Bandhu (Dhrupad Vocalist), Film Script Writer Salim Khan and his son famous actor Salman Khan.

Some of the eminent academicians from Indore are Padma Shri Shambhu Dayal Sinvhal (mathematician, astronomer and former VC of Kumaon University), Padma Bhushan Shri Anil Bordia (an educationist, social activist), Sir Albert Howard (an English botanist who is considered as the father of modern composting), Shri Jyotindra Jain (Indian art and cultural historian and museologist), Padma Shri Dr. Janardan Shankar Mahashabde (an Indian ophthalmologist) and Padma Shri Dr. Janak Palta (a well known social activist). The list also includes Padma Shri Dr. P. S. Hardia (Eye Surgeon) and Dr. Chitranjan Singh Ranavat.

Nine scientists from Indore (four scientists associated with IIT Indore, three with DAVV, and two with RRCAT) have been included in the global list of top scientists in 2020, which was compiled and released by Stanford University (US). The list has 1,59,683 persons out of which nearly 1500 are from India. With time, Indore has also earned and established itself as the commercial capital of the state of MP. Many multinationals have already started their business from the city, like IT conglomerate TCS, Infosys, Impetus, Capgemini, Yash Technologies, CSC. Pithampur is the automobile hub of MP in the vicinity of Indore with their corporate offices in Indore. Automobile manufacturers including VE Commercial Vehicles, Force Motors, MAN Truck & Bus, Pinnacle Industries, Eicher Motors, Eicher Trucks and Buses, Mahle Engine Components, Mahindra Two Wheelers, etc have their manufacturing units in Pithampur. Globally recognized pharmaceutical companies are also operating from Indore like Cipla, Nicolas Piramal, Schon Pharmaceuticals, Torrent, Lupin and Glenmark.

Indore is also a city which has earned laurels in the field of Organ Donation not only in the Central India but at national level too. In recent years, Indore has progressed as one of the ecologically sensitive cities. The city has been awarded with the title of the cleanest city of India five times consecutively. It is a city which is in proximity with two Jyotirlingas - Mahakaleshwar in Ujjain (51 Km) and Omkareshwar (72 Km) in Mandhata, District Khandwa. Another holy place, Maheshwar situated on the banks of river Narmada, has religious and cultural importance. Indore is well connected through road, air and railways to all the major cities of India.

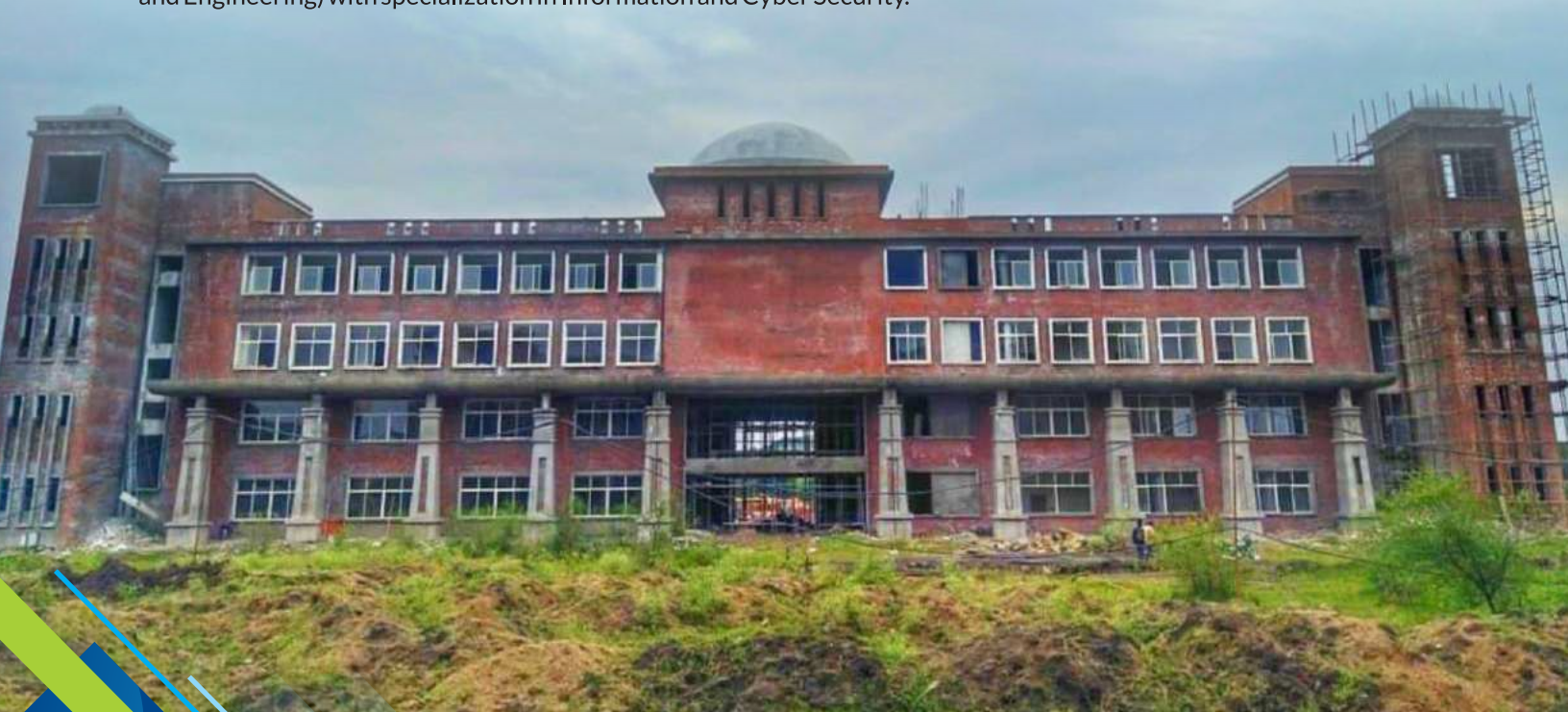

With the establishment of Shri Vaishnav Vidyapeeth Vishwavidyalaya, the name of the library has been changed to Learning Resource Centre (LRC).

The LRC has a total collection of 57900 standard textbooks, reference books, e-journals, databases, and other reading materials in relevant disciplines. For the use of students one copy of each title is kept in the Textbook Collection. The LRC subscribes to 125 national and international journals in print to meet the research requirements of the faculty and researchers.

The LRC provides access to 16000 plus international journals, e-books, and other materials through online access to its members to enhance the information resources for the students and faculty members. The e-resources are available to the students on the campus through wi-fi.

The LRC is open for all the students, researchers, and faculty members from 8.00 AM to 5.30 PM. All the

library operations are fully computerized with the OPAC facilitates searching books and knowing the status of the members. In addition, the library provides photocopy service, inter - library loan service, new arrival of books, news clippings, maintenance of previous year question papers, etc. to all its members.

(1) SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR THE MERITORIOUS STUDENTS AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

(A) (New Admission in First Year Only) B.Tech. / B.Tech.+ MBA / B.Tech.+ M.Tech. and other programs

(2) MERIT SCHOLARSHIP (SECOND YEAR ONWARDS)

- Top 10% of the students, who have obtained CGPA of 8.5 and above in a program will be awarded scholarship equivalent to 75% of the Tuition Fee.
- Next 10% of the students, who have obtained CGPA of 8.5 and above in a program will be awarded scholarship equivalent to 50% of the Tuition Fee.

(3) MERIT- CUM - MEANS SCHOLARSHIP (SECOND YEAR ONWARDS)

- Ten Merit-cum-Means scholarships equivalent to 25% of the Tuition Fee will be awarded to the students, whose parental income is Rs. 3,00,000/- or less per annum and have obtained CGPA of 7.5 and above in a program.

The additional points of eligibility for the scholarships at (2) and (3) shall be that:

- the student has passed in all the courses in first attempt only.
- the number of students who have appeared in the end-semester examination of the program is 15 or more.
- the number of students is determined on the basis of rounding off of the 10 percent of the total number of students who have passed first and second semester of the program in single attempt.

(4) TEACHING ASSISTANCESHIP (TA) FOR PH.D STUDENTS

Teaching Assistanceship amounting to Rs. 25,000 and Rs. 27,000 per month will be offered to the Ph.D Scholars admitted in 04 years full time program during first two years and later two years respectively, subject to MHRD/UGC/AICTE Guidelines. The full-time scholars will be required to conduct labs/teaching sessions equivalent to 20 hours of work load per week and assist the concerned faculty. The Assistanceship will stop if a scholar fails to clear the course work in first attempt, or if his/her six-monthly progress report is not satisfactory.

(5) TEACHING ASSISTANCESHIP (TA) FOR M.TECH. STUDENTS

- Assistanceship amounting to Rs 12,400/- per month will be offered to GATE qualified students pursuing M. Tech. Such students will be required to conduct labs equivalent to 10 hours of workload per week and assist the concerned faculty.

(6) SCHOLARSHIPS TO EMPLOYEES AND THEIR WARDS

- Employees of all the Institutions sponsored by Shri Vaishnav Group of Trusts and their wards will be get scholarship equivalent to 50% of Annual Tuition Fees or Rs 25000/-, whichever is less only, for pursuing any program offered by the University.

(7) SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS OF THE INSTITUTIONS SPONSORED BY SHRI VAISHNAV GROUP OF TRUSTS

- Students of all the institutions (Including schools) sponsored by Shri Vaishnav Group of Trusts will get scholarship equivalent to 50% of Annual Tuition Fees or Rs 25000/-, whichever is less only, for pursuing any program offered by the University. The scholarship will stop if a student gets ATKT at any stage of the program.

(8) SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES FOR THE PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED STUDENTS

- Five Scholarships equivalent to 50% of Annual Tuition Fee or Rs. 25,000 only, whichever is less, will be awarded to the students who have more than 40% physical disability (certified by competent medical authority of the state government). The Scholarship will be awarded to only those students who are selected on merit. The Scholarship will stop if a student gets ATKT at any stage of the program.

(9) SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES FOR THE CHILDREN OF DEFENCE PERSONNEL WHO HAD SACRIFICE THEIR LIVES DURING WARFARE / ANTI TERRORIST OR SIMILAR ACTIVITY

- Five Children of Defence Personnel, who had sacrificed their lives during warfare/anti-terrorist or similar activity, will get scholarship equivalent to 50% of Annual Tuition Fees or Rs. 25,000 only, whichever is less, for pursuing a program offered by the University. The children of the Deceased Defence Personnel will be selected based on their merit scores in the respective programs. The Scholarship will stop if a student gets ATKT at any stage of the program. A student will not be eligible to avail more than one Scholarship of the university at any given time.

(10) SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES FOR THE CHILDREN OF CORONA WARRIORS WHO HAD SACRIFICE THEIR LIVES DURING COVID- 19 PANDEMIC

- Children of Corona Warriors, who had lost their lives during the Covid-19 Pandemic, will get a scholarship equivalent to 50% of Annual Tuition Fees or 25,000 only, whichever is less, for pursuing any program offered by the University. The children of Corona Warriors, who were the only bread earners of their families, will be selected on the basis of merit in the qualifying examination in the case of new admission. However, those who are already enrolled with SVVV will be selected on the basis of their CGPA. The Scholarship will Stop if a student gets ATKT at any stage of the program. A student will not be eligible to avail of more than one Scholarship at any given time. (Note: In case a student is receiving a scholarship from any other source, then the difference only will be paid. Further details, if necessary, will be prepared to facilitate implementation.)

PLACEMENTS

The university has designed a rigorous placement and training program for students starting from first semester which continues up to the last semester. The university continuously trains students in the areas of soft skills to increase the employability skills. The university arranges online aptitude and technical tests for the students, industry visits, and guest lectures by corporate professionals to understand the requirements of the corporate world. The university conducts mock interviews of the students to nurture their technical skills so that the students can handle technical interviews effectively. Thus the university leaves no stone unturned in grooming the students. The university has developed strong industry linkages resulting into long term relations with the industry. The university works with a long term vision to bridge the students' aspirations and their career. As a result of sincere efforts of the university and students, a good percentage of the students get placed through on and off campus drive every year.

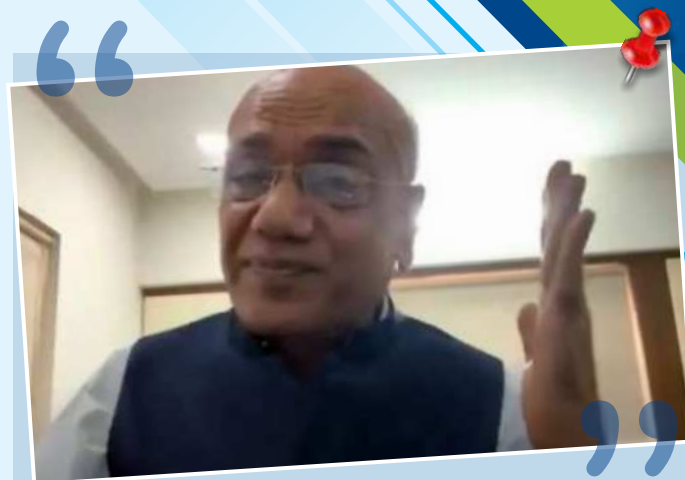

ADMISSION ENTRANCE TEST

Applicants for the Ph. D program shall be selected on the basis of an Entrance Test conducted by the university (SVET), followed by Personal Interview. Those candidates who have passed the NET/SET/GATE or any other equivalent National Test are exempted from the Entrance Test. However, such candidates shall have to go through the Interview Process. The candidates are required to complete six months course work.

Eligibility : The candidate directly seeking admission to Ph.D program should have obtained a Master's degree or equivalent in relevant subject from any recognized university in India or abroad securing not less than 55% marks or 5.5/10 CGPA in aggregate at the Master's Degree. However, in the case of SC/ST candidates the minimum marks required shall be 50% or 5/10 CGPA as per Govt. Guide lines. Those candidates who do not have the required minimum percentage (55% marks) in their Master's Degree, should have completed an AIU recognized /AICTE approved postgraduate diploma in the subject/area/discipline in which he/she seeks to do a Ph. D. and has secured at least 55% marks in such diploma.

SVET is mandatory for Ph.D. in all streams

Shri Vaishnav Entrance Test is held every year for admitting students to various streams in the university.
