Introduction Concept of Normality & Abnormality, Historical Background Approaches to abnormality—Statistical, Evaluative, and Psychodynamic Orientation to Classificatory system (DSM-V, ICD-10). Diathesis Stress Model. Application: Marinating Mental Health.

Unit II

Psychological Models of Psychopathology: Biological, Psychodynamic, Behavioral, Cognitive-Behavioural, Humanistic, Existential, Socio-cultural; **Stress:** Nature, Sources and Types; PTSD and Acute Stress Disorder. Coping with Stress; **Psychosomatic Disorders:** Symptoms, Causes and Treatment.



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Anxiety disorders: Generalized, Conversion Reaction, Phobias, Obsessive Compulsive Disorder. Childhood Disorders: ADHD (Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder), Learning Disability: (Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphia), Slow learner Application: Managing Anxiety.

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Unit IV

Psychchotic Disorders: Mania, Depression, Bipolar affective disorder. Schizophrenia: Symptoms, types: Simple, Paranoid, Catatonic, Hebephrenic, Residual. Application: Managing Moods.

Unit V
