




Student Registration

Process Flow




Step 1

Click on 'JOIN NOW'



Once university activates your account, you will get a notification of the same & then you can log in to NDML NAD system on www.nad.ndml.in


Click on **Login** to access your NAD account using your USER ID & PASSWORD, which will contain your Academic Records once it gets uploaded by your Academic Institution / Board / University
